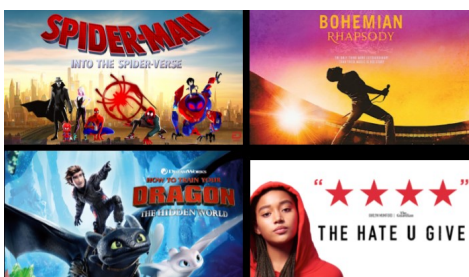
Summer Trip to Bay Lake: July 15-19
