Does prayer change anything?

Prayer is about **JUXTAPOSITION**

Praying with others is both <u>VULNERABLE</u> and <u>POWERFUL</u>

It's all about YOU and not about YOU at all

Do not be anxious about anything. Instead, in every situation, through prayer and petition with thanksgiving, tell your requests to God. And the peace of God that surpasses all understanding will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus. Philippians 4: 6-7

Prayer is about MYSTERY

Prayer doesn't negate our <u>RESPONSIBILITY TO ACT</u>, it enhances it.

Prayer opens us up to **ALTERNATIVE** ways of showing up
