Go Beyond with Trust! We can remember all the ways that we are strong and wise and loved and that can help us to have the power to GO BEYOND AND TRUST!


Start with your family in the Commons and then Pre-K through 5th grade will head to the music room!

Two ways the Bible can be dangerous...

God's Spirit: that which WEAVES LIFE.

This power is not just OUT THERE. It is INSIDE US. It is both WONDEROUS and DANGEROUS.

I have set before you life and death, blessings and curses. Now choose life... Deuteronomy 30:19

The Bible shows us people wrestling with what to do with their freedom and power. Misusing it. Forgetting they have it. Forgetting what it was for and where it came from. *And* learning to use it to weave life more and more deeply.

What is it like to live with this life-weaving Spirit in and around us?

Ezekiel's vision of the valley of dry bones (Ezekiel 37)

This is one of many reminders in the Bible that **there are no circumstances out of which life can't be woven**. And that you and I are a part of the weaving!

You will feel UNSURE. And you TAKE A STEP anyway.

The story of Nicodemus - 3 glimpses in the Gospel of John

Now there was a Pharisee named Nicodemus, a leader of the Jews. He came to Jesus by night... Do not be astonished that I said to you, 'You must be born from above.' The wind blows where it chooses, and you hear the sound of it, but you do not know where it comes from or where it goes. So it is with everyone who is born of the Spirit. John 3.1-2, 7-8

Nicodemus, the man who had come to Jesus earlier and was both a ruler and a Pharisee, spoke up. "Does our Law decide about a man's guilt without first listening to him and finding out what he is doing?" But they cut him off. "Are you also campaigning for the Galilean? John 7:50-52

Nicodemus, who had at first come to Jesus by night, also came... They took the body of Jesus and wrapped it with the spices in linen cloths, according to the burial custom of the Jews. John 19:39-40

There is no FORCING.

For I desire steadfast love and not sacrifice... <u>Hosea 6.6</u> (See also! <u>Jeremiah 31:31-34</u>)

HOPE is REALIZED together.

Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you."... As the Father has sent me, so I send you." When he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained." -John 20:19-23
