It's Hard Not to...CONNECT - week 2

Growing spiritually is the process of aligning your whole self with God's image within you. It's what happens when you grow in all the other areas of your life. It's hard not to do it. One of the things that process does is connect us with others. We all have the image of God within.

Your spiritual growth means connecting with other people. Including people NOT LIKE YOU.

We <u>LIKE</u> connection with people who are like us, and we <u>FEAR</u> connection with people who aren't. *Can you have unity with people who aren't like you*?

Growing spiritually means learning the connection between INDIVIDUALITY and COMMUNITY.

There can be unity without UNIFORMITY. If everyone is like you, some of you are redundant!

For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is through Christ. For in the one spirit we were all baptized into one body—Jews or Greeks, slaves or free—and we were all made to drink of one spirit. If the whole body were an eye, where would the hearing be? If the whole body were hearing, where would the sense of smell be? But as it is, God arranged the members in the body, each one of them, as God chose. If all were a single member, where would the body be? As it is, there are many members, yet one body. The eye cannot say to the hand, 'I have no need of you', nor again the head to the feet, 'I have no need of you.'

It's about TEAMWORK not COMPETITION.


We become <u>WELL-ROUNDED</u> as a community by joining all our <u>WELL-LOPSIDED</u> individuals together.

Unity isn't about being the same, but **BEING HELD TOGETHER BY SOMETHING** even though we are different.

Fabric Core Commitment - We focus on the mission that unites, not the details that divide. We value unity in diversity, not conformity.

What is Fabric held together by? Our MISSION.

- Creating community with significant relationships. (SHARE, CARE, TRUST, GROW) This can happen & works better with diversity!
- · Having and putting into practice CONVERSATIONS THAT MATTER.
- Weaving the 3 strands of True Self, All Others, and the 3rd Strand.
