Preferences are HOW YOU LIKE THINGS TO BE.

Purposes are WHAT REALLY MATTERS. The WHY behind what you want.

People have a preference for closing doors.

But your purposes know that -

- LIFE & GROWTH are not found behind closed doors.
- and that while your preferences tend to be about YOU, your purposes tend to be about US.

We UNDERestimate the energy required to maintain control, keep the status quo, and be comfortable.

And we OVERestimate the energy required to let go.

The idea that life is meant to be lived with open doors is at the core of the Bible and Jesus' message.

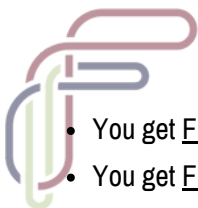
