We're approaching the end of our annual autogiving check-in and we're asking YOU to check in with your Fabric giving if you haven't already done so. Our goal is to increase autogiving by \$500/month through new autogivers or changes for current autogivers. This will help offset a decrease of \$600/month in Fabric's autogiving since January and help stabilize Fabric's finances to meet our budget. As of today, just 13 households have responded with changes to their autogiving totaling \$276/month. Any amount will help us reach our goal!

We need a Purpose to guide our Preference to **DIVIDE** when being together gets hard.

The story of Noah and the Ark, Genesis chapters 6-9

"I establish my covenant with you, that **never again** shall all beings be cut off by the waters of a flood, and never again shall there be a flood to destroy the earth... I have set the rainbow in the clouds, and it shall be a sign of the covenant between me and the earth."

Your preference for keeping your world tidy from the impact of other people's differentness impacts how you CONNECT with them.

Dividing from problematic people deals with them. But are people there to be dealt with? Or to be IN RELATIONSHIP WITH?

If we can't isolate from them, then we try to CONVERT them to our way of thinking, behaving, seeing the world.

But these don't work, they create tribes and resentment, not <u>UNITY</u>.

#### FABRIC CORE COMMITMENT: We seek unity in DIVERSITY not COMFORMITY.

- Ungrounded preferences tend to **SORT YOU OUT** fomr others who are unlike you.
- Purposes tend to UNITE you with others who are unlike you.

Jesus lived out pulling people in without conformity strings attached.

- The Roman centurion Matthew 8.5-13
- The Samaritan woman at the well John 4.1-42
- Jesus' parable of the Samaritan on the road Luke 10.29-37
- Jesus' selection of the unlikely bunch of people to be his disciples

#### Jesus had a very specific way of creating unity out of diversity.

He didn't look for a COMMON DENOMINATOR. A smaller piece behind us that we could all settle for.

He looked forward to something bigger. He held out a VISION WORTH PURSUING.

He gave people a bigger purpose. Something higher, more satisfying, meaningful, fulfilling.

Jesus called that purpose the kingdom of heaven. What's that?

- In Fabric-ese Anywhere people aligh with how the fabric of the universe is truly woven.
- In Bible-ese It appears when we live according to the will of God.

When we make this move our vision gets **BIGGER** and our actions get **PERSONAL**.

If Fabric doesn't rely on conformity to create unity, what holds us together? What makes YOU Fabric?
